# **Rules Please read carefully.**

### **Entry Forms:**

- 1. A separate entry form must be used for each entrant. Extra forms are available from the Otley Post Office, tel: 01473 890257 or Vanessa Ling on 890787 or Helen Quilliam on 890594.
- 2. Completed entry forms to be sent as early as possible, but not later than 6.00 pm on Wednesday 4th September 2013 to the Otley Post Office. Entry forms with the correct money should be placed in a sealed envelope.

#### **Cups:**

All cups should be handed back to Mary Hunt (01473 890518) for engraving by 1<sup>st</sup> July.

#### **Entries:**

- The village hall will be open from 8.00 am and all exhibits must be in place and the hall vacated by 10.00 am, as judging starts at 10.15 am.
- An exhibitor may show only one entry per class.
- All entries must be made or grown by the exhibitor.
- A lettuce may not be entered as a vegetable in Class 1.
- Preserves and cookery exhibits, art and handicraft items must be the work of the exhibitor.
- All perishable items in the cookery section must be wrapped in film.
- Craft items made from a kit must be clearly labelled as such.
- No group entries will be allowed.
- All photos should be unframed, with a maximum size of 7" x 5".
- A family consists of two generations living at the same address.
- Exhibits may not be removed from the hall before 3.30 pm.
- All exhibits remaining after this time will be auctioned, UNLESS THE EXHIBITOR STATES OTHERWISE.

#### **Judging:**

- 1. Judges have the right to withhold prizes in any class where the quality does not merit an award.
- 2. Where there are less than 5 entries in a class, 3<sup>rd</sup> prize will be awarded at the judges' discretion.

#### Allocation of Points:

- 1. First prize is awarded 3 points.
- 2. Second prize is awarded 2 points.
- 3. Third prize is awarded 1 point.
